3 Valentine's Day Dangers to Pets

A bouquet of flowers, a box of candy and a chocolate heart may be a delight for you, but they are a possible hidden health risk for your dog or cat.



1. Chocolate

Unfortunately, chocolate contains **theobromine**, an extreme stimulant to pets. It causes a racing heart and stimulates the central nervous system. The darker the chocolate, the more dangerous for your pet.



2. Low-Sugar Candy

It may contain an artificial sweetener called **xylitol**. In pets, xylitol stimulates the pancreas to produce insulin, which suppresses blood sugar levels. Xylitol can also cause liver damage.



3. Flowers

Beware of bouquets containing **lilies** — specifically, the big showy ones in floral displays. If your cat chews on the leaves or petals, drinks the water, or rubs against the pollen and grooms herself, she is at risk of kidney failure.



Parts of the Home Exterior

<u>body/wall:</u> siding, downspouts, utility connections, cable, phone box <u>trim:</u> soffit, gutters, doors, garage, solar piping on wall, contrasting boarder around windows

accent: front door, shutters
